LIAISON REPORT

Council Report (Council Member Dominguez):

- Milpitas Police dept is doing a great job sharing the public service announcements.
- Milpitas Police is partnering with Santa Clara County for resources for crime victims.
- Milpitas Police Dept. is working with groups to support resources for victims of domestic violence. Councilmember Dominguez is recommending the commission to attend a walk thru in the future to domestic violence shelter.

Milpitas Unified School District (MUSD) Report (School Board Member Lien):

- School is back and in person, weekly COVID tests for staff.
- School District secured a \$15M bond.

Emergency Management Report (Coordinator Charlop):

- Emergency Operations Plan was adopted by Council in August.
- CERT Connex boxes are coming online, Cardoza is completed.

Fire Report (Chief Maloon):

- Currently interviewing firefighters to run an academy from February to June.
- All Deployments have returned to station, up to 10-12 firefighters gone at a time.
- Purchase of a new fire engine to be delivered next year.
- Ambulance coming into service July 2022.

Police (Captain Torrez):

- Milpitas Police conducted pedestrian safety traffic enforcement, generating 14 citations to drivers for a failure to yield to pedestrian.
