IX. Old Business

1. Public Art Project Conceptual Review for 1500 Centre Pointe Development – Marshall Torre

Background: At the November 28, 2016 meeting the Arts Commission reviewed a series of art pieces that will be installed at Centre Pointe Housing Development. The artists' bios and examples of their past works as well as proposed art location were presented to the Commission.

Recommendation: Receive project presentation and provide input and feedback to consultant.

2. Park Public Art Project Dedication for Larry Voellger, Higuera Adobe Park – Staff Cacao

Background: At the September 26, 2016 meeting the Arts Commission discussed initial ideas for the project which included sustainable/environmental materials, and a gateway piece. The commission approved Higuera Adobe Park as the project location. At the March 26, 2018 meeting the Arts Commission further discussed the art project to include recycled art and keeping theater arts as the main theme.

Recommendation: Receive draft Request for Proposal packets and recommend for public distribution.
