VIII. New Business

1. Active Transportation Plan Update – Fanny Yu, Associate Civil Engineer – City of Milpitas

Background: Fanny Yu, Associate Civil Engineer with the City of Milpitas would like to update the Senior Advisory Commission on the Active Transportation Plan. This effort is to encourage feedback on the vision and action plan for the city to improve safe and convenient travel modes in Milpitas.

Background: During the COVID-19 Pandemic, Senior Center staff have continued to offer on-site “to-go” lunch to senior participants through the Senior Nutrition Program. Recently, the Senior Center has additionally begun offering “to-go” meals delivered to Terrace Garden residents at their door Monday through Friday. This program is funded by the Community Development Block Grant to support providing healthy meals to seniors during the pandemic. The Senior Center has also initiated a “Technology for Seniors” program that provides a Chromebook device for loan for qualifying seniors. Seniors enrolled in this program also receive an orientation on Chromebook basics and ongoing tech support led by SJSU student interns.

Recommendation: Receive an update on current programs and projects currently offered to seniors.
