- a. Work Plan Events – Confirm Virtual Events -

Background: The Youth Advisory Commission is partnering with local groups to develop and execute events for community engagement. Related to the following Grants: Women's Suffrage (Encouragement of registration for voting) and Tobacco Free Communities: Restricting the sale of flavored tobacco products, including menthol cigarettes (Encouragement and Support of information to restrict the sale of e-cigarette and vaping devices, and/or other tobacco products.

Recommendation: Commission to provide feedback on decision of events, to which include dates, times, and locations.

b. Work Plan Proposal 2020-21

Background: Founded April 1996, the Youth Advisory Commission was established to advise the City Council on matters pertaining to youth and teens in Milpitas. Commissioners must be students in grades 7 through 12 and live in Milpitas.

Recommendation: Review Fiscal Year 2019-20 Work Plan and establish key tasks for proposal in Fiscal Year 2020-21 for recommendation to City Council.

c. YAC Social – City Staff

Background: Each year, local YAC's (or commissions like) participate in a social event, to which commissions from other cities come together and discuss information regarding youth needs/concerns/opportunities.
