5. **New Business**

- Pilot Shuttle Program - Milpitas OnDemand

Planning Department staff provided a presentation of the pilot shuttle program that is to be funded by Measure B grant to provide first and last mile transit service to major transit hub locations within Milpitas.

- Exploring “Botts Dots” for Traffic Calming Applications

Staff provided a presentation on pavement markers, “Botts Dots”, usage. City of Oakland and Contra Costa County are conducting pilot projects that utilize pavement markers, “Botts Dots”, to discourage vehicle stunting activities at intersections in their respective jurisdiction. These pilot projects are in progress and pavement marker effectiveness in these conditions is yet to be determined. Pavement markers could also be configured as a rumble strip to provide tactile and audible feedback warnings of roadway hazards ahead. However, pavement markers as rumble strips are not effective in slowing vehicle travel speed on clear unobstructed roadways. Research studies showed they affected vehicle speed by less than 1 mph under these conditions, making it ineffective as a traffic calming measure.

The committee supports usage of pavement markers configured as rumble strips to warn motorists of approaching curves, conflicts, and hazards in the city. The committee requests creation of a pilot pavement marker project for full city council consideration. The proposed pilot project would evaluate accident reduction effectiveness of pavement marker rumble strip and determine community support for their placements notwithstanding their noise generation.
