



MEETING MINUTES CITY OF MILPITAS

5. **New Business**

a. Proposed Residential Speed Hump Policy Amendment

Staff presented a proposed policy amendment to reduce the speed hump request support by a 50% majority from the affected residential street in lieu of the current greater than 70% majority support. Additionally, a requirement that all households adjacent to speed humps must provide support for speed hump installation was also included in the proposed amendment. Subcommittee recommended to move the proposed Speed Hump Policy Amendment to full city council consideration.

b. Review traffic assessment and action plan for the following intersections:

- i. Park Victoria Blvd/Kennedy Drive
- ii. S. Park Victoria Blvd/Mt. Shasta Avenue
- iii. Kennedy Drive/Fanyon Street

Staff conducted traffic signal warrants for the three intersections. None of the intersections met warrants for a traffic signal installation. Staff identified the following suitable improvements consistent with Traffic Calming best practice instead:

- Install Red Flashing Beacons to reinforce 4-way stop control and install Enhance Green Bike Lane stripping at the N. Park Victoria/Kennedy intersection.
- Install Pedestrian Crosswalk Warning Beacons at the following intersections:
 - S. Park Victoria/Mt. Shasta
 - Kennedy Dr./Fanyon St.

These improvements will be incorporated into the Street Resurfacing Project currently under construction.
