III. PUBLIC HEARING

III-1 MILPITAS MATERIALS ACCESSORY WAREHOUSE ADDITION – 1125 N. Milpitas Blvd. – P-SD19-0002: A request for a Site Development Permit to legalize an existing 3,934-square foot accessory building in the southwestern portion of the site. The project is categorically exempt from further environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(e) (Existing Facilities), CEQA Guidelines Section 15303(e) (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures), and as a separate and independent basis, CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 (Projects Consistent with a Community Plan, General Plan, or Zoning).

Recommendation: Staff recommend that the Zoning Administrator APPROVE P-SD19-0002, to allow for the construction of a 3,934 square foot new accessory building on the valley floor, subject to the findings set forth in this report and the attached Conditions of Approval.

Any person aggrieved by any final decision of any, board, commission, or department head to the City of Milpitas may appeal the decision to the City Council by filing written notice of the appeal with the City Clerk within 12 calendar days of the date of said decision and paying the required fee. This time limit shall be strictly enforced.
