a. Hall Tennis Courts Conversion Discussion – Recreation and Community Services Department Staff

Background: The City Council directed staff to conduct a 1-year Pickleball Pilot program which began August 2022 and ended in August 2023. The pilot program created temporary pickleball courts at Hall Park Tennis Courts and Gill Park Handball Courts. Usage at both courts were monitored, along with decibel readings. In April 2023 a survey was made available to Hall Court users (pickleball and tennis) on the Pickleball Pilot and permanent court conversion at the site. As part of the 2024-28 Capital Improvement Program, the City Council allocated \$100,000 for creation of permanent pickleball courts in Milpitas. On Monday, September 25, 2023, a community meeting was held to discuss the potential permanent conversion of courts at Hall Park to pickleball. The feedback from the community meeting, survey responses, and project cost valuations will inform a future recommendation for permanent pickleball courts to Milpitas City Council.

Recommendation: Receive presentation from City Staff and provide feedback to City Council on permanent pickleball courts in Milpitas.

b. Work Plan FY23-24 Review – Recreation and Community Services Department Staff

Background: The Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Commission was established with the purpose of advising City Council on matters pertaining to recreation, bicycle, and pedestrian trails and access, historic preservation, planning and development of new and existing parks and facilities, and identifying, protecting, and enhancing structures and other features reflecting special aspects of the City's cultural heritage. The Commission's Fiscal Year 2023-24 Work Plan which identifies goals, projects, and ongoing tasks that the Commission plans to work on and accomplish was approved by City Council on September 17, 2023.

Recommendation: Review Fiscal Year 2023-24 Work Plan and identify the work plan tasks Commissioners would like to work on.
