- a. **Pulte Homes Residential Project's Private Park Located at 1355 California Circle – Planning Department Staff**

Background: The City of Milpitas received an application from Pulte Homes to allow the development of a multi-family residential project of 206 residential units. The project will also include a 0.32-acre internal private park. The City Council approved the project on November 7, 2023.

Recommendation: Receive a presentation on the Project and provide courtesy feedback to staff and developer.

- b. **Sister Cities Work Plan Discussion – Recreation and Community Services Department Staff**

Background: The Sister Cities program includes supporting and promoting relationships that already exist within the community. As part of the Commission's work plan, the Commission

needs to research international relationships that Milpitas schools, nonprofits, and services clubs already have in place.

Recommendation: Discuss Sister Cities and the direction of the program, create a sub-committee of up to three (3) members to research existing relationships with schools, nonprofits, and clubs, and report back in February 2024.

c. June Park Tour Discussion – Recreation and Community Services Department Staff

Background: Annually the Commission selects a park to visit and tour as part of the Annual Park/Facility Tour item on your work plan. Staff will lead the discussion on deciding the site(s) and theme of the tour.

Recommendation: Discuss and decide the location of the annual tour and meeting start time.
