- A. Council Report (Councilmember Lien):
 - a. CM Lien attended the National League of Cities Conference in Washington, DC.
 - b. Congressman Ro Khanna funded a grant of \$500K for the Main Street revitalization.
 - c. On Saturday, 3/23 Milpitas Rotary Club, City of Milpitas, Troop 163, Troop 2163, and Our City Forest organization that provided the trees, equipment, and guidance on planting trees at Pinewood Park. Milpitas Rotary Club will provide lunch for all volunteers.
 - d. On April 6, another Arbor Day at Pinewood. (No lunch will be provided)
 - e. Thanks to Santa Clara District Attorney Jeff Rosen and Milpitas Chief of Police Jared Hernandez for hosting the forum on Retail Theft. Raising awareness to business owners to combat Retail Theft.
- B. MUSD Report (Schoolboard Member Yip-Chuan):
 - a. MUSD got a \$2 million grant for career technical Education initiatives that will be used to support our new programming at the Milpitas High School Extension and enhancing our Milpitas High School academies.
 - b. Russell Middle School is now a distinguished school based on its data in the dashboard which can be found by googling CDE dashboard.
