a. Senior Center Event Sock Hop –Chair Langley

Background: The Senior Advisory Commission's Work Plan includes supporting and promoting select Senior Center activities, such as birthday celebrations, themed dances, multi-cultural events, and highlighting activities to increase participation from our Milpitas older adult community. The Senior Center will host a Sock Hop dance on October 18, 2024, between 4:00 and 6:00 p.m. Staff are seeking volunteers from the Commission to help at the event and additionally are asking that commissioners help promote the event in the community.

Recommendation: Discuss how the Senior Advisory Commission can assist in promoting the Sock Hop event and recruit volunteers from the Commission for the various event duties.

b. The Walk to End Alzheimers – Chair Langley

Background: In 2023, the Senior Advisory Commission collaborated with the staff at the Barbara Lee Senior Center to raise awareness about dementia. In September of 2023, Commissioners and staff participated for the first time in the Walk to End Alzheimer’s Silicon Valley event, organized by the Alzheimer’s organization. Currently, the commission aims to prioritize awareness of dementia among adults in the Milpitas community and encourage their involvement in these types of events. The next Walk to End Alzheimer’s Silicon Valley is scheduled for Saturday, September 28, 2024.
