- a. **Transportation Development Act – Article 3 (TDA3 3) – Roberto Alonzo, Public Works Division Manager**

Background: The Transportation Development Act – Article 3 (TDA 3) is a grant program administered by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) that allows Counties to establish a quarter-cent tax to provide funding exclusively for pedestrian and bicycle projects. Staff will be presenting an upcoming street resurfacing project that includes both bicycle and pedestrian improvements, which TDA 3 grant money could be used for.

Recommendation: Receive presentation and recommend City Council prioritize the TDA Article 3 Bicycle and Pedestrian projects and plans in order to receive TDA 3 Funding.

b. Recreation Quarterly Report: Special Events Program Presentation – Recreation and Community Services Staff
