b. Presentation on Bicycle Repair Clinic – Recreation and Community Services Staff

Background: Staff will present a recounting of the Recreation and Community Services bicycle repair clinic in 2024 and the upcoming clinic in 2025. Supporting this event is part of the Commission's annual Work Plan in the Bicycle & Pedestrian Trails area.

Recommendation: Receive the presentation.

c. Family Bike Day Event and Bike to Work Day– Recreation and Community Services Staff

Background: The Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Resources Commission advises the City Council on matters pertaining to bicycle and pedestrian trails. The Commission hosts an annual family bike day event in Milpitas, encouraging residents to ride and experience the many trails in Milpitas. At the September 5, 2024, meeting, the Commission decided to hold the event on Saturday, May 17, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. on the Gill Park Trail. Volunteers for this event were Commissioner Ashby, Commissioner Davis, and Commissioner Strauss who will perform tasks such as greeting families, and potentially riding the trail. Bike to Work Day will be held on Thursday, May 15, 2025, at 6:00 a.m. in front of City Hall. We will need two (2) volunteers for this event.

Recommendation: Receive the presentation and obtain two (2) volunteers for the Bike to Work Event.
