- a. **Genesys Alert and Warning System – Toni Charlop, C.E.M., Emergency Management Coordinator - Fire**

Background: The Milpitas Fire Department's Office of Emergency Management is reaching out to educate the community regarding the use of Genesys Protect as a quick and efficient means of providing direction to the public in an emergency.

Recommendation: Receive the presentation on Genesys alert and warning system.

b. Senior Center Event Sock Hop – Chair Langley

Background: The Senior Advisory Commission's Work Plan includes supporting and promoting select activities at the Senior Center, such as birthday celebrations, themed dances, and multi-cultural events. The goal is to increase participation from the Milpitas senior community. Staff have scheduled the event on Friday, October 3, 2025, 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the Senior Center. They are seeking volunteers from the Commission to assist with the Sock Hop and encourage commissioners to help promote the event within the community.

Recommendation: Discuss how the Senior Advisory Commission can assist in promoting the Sock Hop event. Additionally, gather commitments from the Commissioners to participate as volunteers and discuss various responsibilities for the event.

c. 2025 Walk to End Alzheimer’s (Silicon Valley) – Vice Chair Berryhill

Background: As part of the Senior Advisory Commission Work Plan aimed at supporting "Age Friendly" initiatives, the Commission is engaged in activities related to the Santa Clara County Seniors’ Agenda, focusing on senior health, wellness, and mental well-being. The Commission plans to participate once again in the 2025 Walk to End Alzheimer’s (Silicon Valley) event, scheduled for Saturday, October 11, 2025, at Lake Cunningham Park.
