Background:

As part of the Senior Advisory Commission Work Plan, the Commission seeks to enhance awareness of community resources available to older adults. These include programs and services related to housing assistance, food support, transportation, and health and wellness.

In addition, this effort supports raising awareness of Alzheimer's disease and other conditions that impact the well-being of older adults and their families. Increasing community understanding helps reduce stigma, promote compassion, and connect residents to supportive services such as Milpitas HOPE, Dementia Friends, and other local initiatives.

Recommendation:

Continue discussion on ways to enhance community awareness of senior resources and social service programs. Develop and share new ideas to promote the Senior Center's Resource Area and related initiatives such as Milpitas HOPE and Dementia Friends.
