a. Innovation District Parks and trails Master Plan Study Session – City Staff

Background: Within the Innovation Subdistrict of the Milpitas Metro Specific Plan area, a publicly accessible park is planned adjacent to Berryessa Creek and the new roadway connection to S. Milpitas Boulevard Extension. The proposed park is designed to provide recreational opportunities for workers and provide open space in a district that currently lacks park space. Although the Innovation District prioritizes office and R&D development, it allows residential development adjacent to the proposed parks to create a campus-like setting. The proposed parks will serve employees and visitors to the area. Staff will present the Innovation District Parks and Trails Master Plan background, results of the public engagement thus far, and the developed conceptual designs.

Recommendation: Receive presentation and provide feedback on the preferred park and trail design for the Innovation District Parks and Trails Master Plan.

b. Recommend the Parks and Recreation and Community Services Programs Donation for a Memorial Bench in Honor of Segundo Cacao for City Council Final Approval – City Staff

Background: As part of the City’s donation policy to Parks and Recreation and the commission’s work plan, a donation for a memorial bench. Application needs to be reviewed and accepted and make a recommendation for consideration during final approval at a future City Council meeting.

Recommendation: Receive the memorial bench donation request and make recommendation for acceptance for City Council consideration.
