9. Business Items
 - a. Commission Advisory Area Discussion

Background: As part of the Commission's Work Plan, the Commission is to discuss and provide high-level feedback and suggestions regarding youth and teen concerns, areas that need improvement or need to be focused on, and advise City Council on pertinent youth and teen topics. In the previous meeting, littering on campus, drug use at school, peer pressure, mental health, and students eating in restrooms or sitting by themselves were discussed.

Recommendation: Discuss any topics, challenges, and concerns that Commissioners have observed pertaining to youth and teens in our community.

b. Commission Volunteering at Teen Center Events

Background: As part of the Commission's Work Plan, the Commission will volunteer and support Milpitas Teen Center events and the annual Teen Center Halloween event, City events, and provide volunteer opportunities for Milpitas teens in partnership with the Milpitas Teen Center.

Recommendation: Debrief the past events that the Commission volunteered for. Review upcoming volunteering assignments. Continue discussing volunteer opportunities for Milpitas teens.

c. College Workshop

Background: As part of the Commission's Work Plan, the Commission would like to host a college workshop in December 2025. The workshop would be led by a community-based organization. In the last meeting, the Commission discussed different topics including college applications, major and career exploration, transferring from a community college to a university, and FAFSA/grants. The Commission also discussed creating a survey to ask high school students what college topics they would like to learn about.

Recommendation: Finalize all college workshop logistics.

d. Year-Round Sports with Milpitas Teen Center

Background: As part of the Commission's Work Plan, the Commission would like to host 4-6 drop-in sports days at the Milpitas Sports Center in partnership with the Milpitas Teen Center. In the last meeting, the Commission was interested in including badminton. The Commission also discussed creating a survey to ask high school students for suggested sports to have at drop-in sports.

Recommendation: Discuss drop-in sports logistics including what days to host drop-in sports, what additional sports to add, and promotion of drop-in sports.
