- b. **Update on the Draft 2025 Urban Water Management Plan and Water Shortage Contingency Plan -- Howard Salamanca, Associate Engineer, and Samantha Vergara, Water Conservation Coordinator**

The California Department of Water Resources (DWR) requires urban water suppliers to prepare an Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) every five years. These plans support the suppliers' long-term resource planning to ensure that adequate water supplies are available to meet existing and future water needs of the community. City staff have been working with a technical consultant to prepare the 2025 UWMP and WSCP for the City's water system in accordance with DWR guidance. Staff will provide a brief overview of the draft UWMP and WSCP.
