ZONING MAP AND TEXT AMENDMENT FOR SB79 – CITYWIDE – P-ZA26-0002: A City-initiated Zoning Text and Map Amendment to amend Title XIII (Zoning) to create a Transit-Oriented Development Overlay district designating areas eligible for Senate Bill (SB 79) height and density standards. The proposed zoning map and text amendments are statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act under Government Code Section 65912.160(c)(2) (SB 79).
