8. Business Items

a. Main Street Extra Shine Car Wash Historical Display Review – Recreation and Community Services Department Staff

Background: In accordance with directions from the City Council at the May 4, 2021, public hearing, the Main Street Extra Shine Car Wash (project) is required to include and maintain a historical display highlighting people, activities, or events associated with the project site and Main Street. The display must be reviewed and approved by the PRCRC for its size, design, and content prior to installation. Owners of Extra Shine Car Wash will present the proposed historical display and seek Commission feedback and approval of the final display. The display is required to be installed prior to issuance of the project's Certificate of Occupancy.

Recommendation: Review the proposed Historic Display and either approve or deny Historic Display.

b. VTA Bicycle & Pedestrian Committee Representative – Chair Davis

Background: The City of Milpitas has a membership seat on the VTA Bicycle & Pedestrian Committee (BPAC), which consists of 16 members representing each of the 15 cities and the County. The BPAC advises the Board on funding and planning issues for bicycle and

pedestrian projects. It also serves as the countywide bicycle advisory committee for Santa Clara County. The Committee generally meets on the Wednesday following the first Thursday of each month at VTA River Oaks Campus, 3331 North First Street at 6:30 p.m. A new volunteer member is needed from the Commission. Following the receipt of a volunteer, the name will be forwarded to the Mayor for recommendation for confirmation at a future City Council meeting.

Recommendation: Receive a volunteer from the Commission to serve on the VTA Bicycle & Pedestrian Committee.
