 - 1. Council approved the purchase order for three new P.D. vehicles, a five-year term for the fire department's annual physicals, the sanitary/sewer pipeline improvement plan project, and the street resurfacing and repair plan.
 - 2. Council approved the City Clerk Staff recommendation for quarterly commissioner assignment updates.
 - 3. Council approved \$1.5M in Fire Department PPE.
 - 4. Council approved 109 multi-family townhomes to be built at McCandless with 10 ADU's.
 - 5. New City Manager starts June 1.
- B. MUSD Report (Schoolboard Member Yip-Chuan):
 - 1. MUSD broke ground on Phase III of the Innovation Campus.
 - 2. MUSD school is out June 5.
 - 3. MHS graduation will be June 6.
 - 4. May 26th is the next school board meeting.
- C. Emergency Management Report (OEM Coordinator Charlop):
 - 1. OEM "graduated" 20 new CERT members from the May class.
 - 2. The OEM portable is near ready state with a move in date projected in June.
- D. Fire (BC Bankston):
 - 1. FD is hosting a wildland refresher course.
 - 2. FD is hiring two firefighters to fill vacancies.
 - 3. FD is decommissioning a wildland rig.
- E. Police (Lt. Sanchez):
 - 1. MPD has two recent retirees.
 - 2. MPD has a new trainee in the academy.
 - 3. MPD has a new community service officer.
 - 4. MPD has two new hires nearly complete with their field training.
