CALL TO ORDER	Chair Sexton called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Staff Marshall called the roll.

PLEDGE of ALLEGIANCE	Chair Sexton led the pledge of allegiance.

ANNOUNCEMENTS	Deputy PW Director Marshall shared that the City Manager has appointed Christian Di Renzo as the City's new Public Works Director. He will start with the City on December 12, 2022. Councilmember Chua announced that the Parks and Recreation Commission is looking for additional commissioners.
BUSINESS ITEMS	a. Update on Garbage and Recycling Services and SB 1383 Implementation Myvan Khuu-Seeman, Solid Waste Program Senior Analyst, and Alan Ha, Solid Waste Program Administrative Analyst, provided an update on the City's garbage and recycling services and SB 1383 implementation. Commissioners asked clarifying questions and discussed how they could provide additional support to improve community awareness, increase participation, and reduce contamination.

LIAISON REPORT

Councilmember Chua encouraged everyone to attend the City's Tree Lighting Ceremony on December 1st, and asked that the Commissioners spread the word and encourage friends, family, and neighbors to join one of the City's commissions. Councilmember Chua also announced that the Catalytic Converter Program is on-going and available through the Police Department.

Deputy Director Marshall shared that the City's reduced its overall water use by 19% compared to 2019 which exceeds Valley Water and State water conservation targets, and that the last Landscape Workshop will be held on November 29th.
