- a. **Milpitas Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Update Zoning Advisory Group Appointment**
–The City of Milpitas is seeking representatives from various City commissions to join the Zoning Advisory Group (ZAG) and advise on the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Update, which will update the City's outdated Zoning Ordinance to further the 2040 General Plan goals and policies. The ZAG is an ad hoc committee composed of existing City commissions and will convene at key points during the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Update process to review working material and provide insight and feedback. Participation by members appointed to the ZAG is temporary; the roles and responsibilities of its members will conclude with City Council adoption of the project, which is anticipated to occur in approximately 2.5 years.
- b. **Citizens Climate Lobby Presentation** – *At the March meeting, the Commission voted to schedule a presentation to learn more about the efforts of the Silicon Valley East Chapter of the Citizen's Climate Lobby and discuss opportunities for collaboration.*
