1. Receive Presentation on the Parks and Recreation Master Plan Update (City Staff)

Background: The City Parks and Recreation Master Plan Update is in the approved City 2020-2025 Capital Improvement Program. This project provides an update to the existing 2008 Parks and Recreation Master Plan document to include Transit Area Specific Plan Parks, Midtown Parks, and City recreational facilities. The update will focus on the connectivity within the park as well as between parks and recreation facilities including trails. It also includes an assessment of Recreation and Community Services programs and fees.

Recommendation: Receive an interim update on Parks and Recreation Master Plan.

Background: The Commission's proposed Fiscal Year 2020-21 Work Plan identified goals, projects and ongoing tasks that the Commission can continue to work on and accomplish in Fiscal Year 2020-21.
