9. Business Items

a. Bobby Sox Fields – City Staff

Background: Milpitas is home to many youth sport organizations that serve residents through sports like football, baseball, rugby, softball and soccer. Currently, Milpitas has softball fields located at Cardoza Park, Gill Park and Thomas Russell Middle School (MUSD property). The recent Bond Measure includes renovation of existing sports fields at Russell Middle school to a full size running track, softball field for players under 8 years of age, and a multi-sport practice field.

The Milpitas North Valley PAL (formerly Milpitas North Valley Bobby Sox) softball organization has approximately 150 girls participating in softball and have utilized the Russell Fields for practices and games since 1997. With the planned renovation of the fields, the City will be allocating fields located at Dixon Landing Park to Bobby Sox through its normal Field Allocation process. Also planned as part of a currently funded Capital Improvement Plan project for City field maintenance and improvements is making Dixon Landing fields multi-use for both softball and baseball.

Recommendation: Receive project update and provide comment and considerations.

b. Recreation Quarterly Report: Virtual Community Center – City Staff

Background: Recreation and Community Services Department Assistant Director Tegan McLane will introduce Milpitas' Virtual Community Center, an online collection of curated recreation experiences for residents during shelter-in-place and any time they are unable to participate in person.
