Business Items

a. Historic Inventory List Update – staff

Background: At the March 1st meeting, the Historic Inventory Subcommittee provided an update on their findings of the Historic Inventory List. Some locations were unsure of to see if these buildings were still in-tact, a recommendation to drive by once more was made. Any structures that are no longer a visual cultural resource will need to be noted. In addition, staff would like to retain history of all family affiliations to these historical sites. An addendum to the Historical Inventory List should include other buildings that were recommended.

Recommendation: Subcommittee to review historic inventory list, provide necessary updates.

b. Annual Park/Facility Tour – staff

Background: As part of the Commission annual Work Plan, the Commission schedules a tour to visit buildings and parks that have been newly renovated or of historical significance to the Commissioners.

Recommendation: Decide on facilities and parks to visit, date and time for a socially distanced tour in June.
