1. Milpitas Sports Center Updated Master Plan Review

Background: The approved 2018-2023 CIP Program included a project to update the Milpitas Sports Center (MSC) Master Plan. This plan focuses on revising several elements due to a number of changes to the site amenities. Elements include vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle circulation, fields, drainage, and ADA improvements. The City hired consultant Verde Designs to work with City staff, conduct community meetings with MSC stakeholders, and prepare an updated Master Plan for review and approval by the City Council.

Recommendation: Receive presentation from Verde Designs and make recommendation to City Council for approval.

2. Bike to Work Day

Background: The City of Milpitas participates annually in National Bike to Work Day. This year, the PRCRC with its new role advising on Bicycle and Pedestrian topics will be involved. Bike to Work Day is on Thursday, May 9th this year.

Recommendation: Receive a brief review of the event and receive volunteers for various work areas.
