a. Receive a Presentation on the draft City of Milpitas Trails, Pedestrian, and Bicycle Master Plan, Project No. 3448

Background: The Trails, Pedestrian, and Bicycle Master Plan is in the approved City 2020-2021 Capital Improvement Program. This project provides an update to the existing 1997 Trails Master Plan and the 2009 Bicycle Master Plan document. The plan will focus on updating existing trails, bicycle, and pedestrian routes and make recommendations for facilities improvements, programs, and policies.

Recommendation: Receive presentation on the draft City of Milpitas Trails, Pedestrian, and Bicycle Master Plan, Project No. 3448

b. Proposed 2021-2026 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) – Park Projects Priority

Background: Annually the Commission reviews Park Projects listed in the City's five-year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) to recommend project priority for City Council consideration. City Staff will review the list of Park projects.

Recommendation: Receive the Park Projects in the proposed 2021-2026 Capital Improvement Program and make recommendation for project priority for City Council consideration.

c. Historic Inventory List Update – staff

Background: Current review of historic site list including an annual tour of the historic pieces and include on-line webpage of findings

Recommendation: Subcommittee to review historic inventory list, provide necessary updates.

d. Park Marker program update – staff

Background: The Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Commission work includes Park Name History Project Phase 2. Commissioners will establish a subcommittee to research Park Names and Develop a bio of their findings. An on-line webpage should be part of this item which will provide historical information on park names and physical park markers.

City staff will work with subcommittee to identify the cost, funding source, and development of an installation plan. The Arts Commission will receive request for proposals for potential artist to design the physical markers.
